5. Public Hearings
 - a. Public Hearing to solicit public input on a proposed Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) proposal to be submitted to the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development for the Yuma-Alpine Ridge Sewer Project. The proposed project will involve the installation of new public wastewater infrastructure in the Yuma community.
 - b. Public Hearing to amend the Scott County FY2026 Budget. Amendments include an increase in funds to the General County Fund totaling \$1,699,596; an increase in funds to the Regional Improvements Fund totaling \$69,200; an increase in funds to the IT Technology Fund (Clerk) totaling \$34,168; a decrease in funds to the American Rescue Plan Act Fund totaling \$7,810; and increase in funds to the Upper Cliff Mountain Water Project totaling \$62,843; a decrease in funds to Scott County Head Start totaling \$420,892; and an increase in funds to the Scott County School Operating Fund totaling \$5,257,522. Total expense changes equal \$6,694,627.
 - c. Public Hearing on the possible adoption of an Ordinance to Amend and Reenact the Real Estate Tax Exemption Ordinance for Elderly Individuals and Individuals with Disabilities to reflect a change in Section 10, the amount of exemption.
 - d. Public Hearing on the possible adoption of an Ordinance Establishing a County-Wide Fire Tax District in Scott County, Virginia.

- e. Public Hearing on the Proposed Budget for Scott County, Virginia for Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2026.
 - f. Public Hearing for the purpose of considering a possible tax levy increase on real property for the Fiscal Year 2027 Budget. The current real property tax levy is set at \$0.77/\$100 of assessed value of real property. This hearing will be to consider setting the FY 27 real property tax rate at \$0.75/100 and adding a \$0.04 Fire Tax.
